Thank you for your resubmission of the Domestic Homicide Review (DHR) report (06) for Cardiff Community Safety Partnership to the Home Office. The report was assessed by the Home Office Secretariat in October 2021.

The Home Office noted that issues raised in the feedback letter following the first submission have been addressed. The view of the Home Office is that the DHR may be published.

There are a few areas of development the QA Panel wish for you to note

- The CSP should ensure that future submissions are appropriately referenced, and that the currency of the research cited is targeted and specific to the facts of the review.
- It is of concern that the local Women's Aid service did not have capacity to act as a panel member in this case...This should be addressed by local commissioners.
- The name of the institution remains in the Executive Summary and the Overview report.

The Home Office would be grateful if you could provide us with a digital copy of the final version of the report with all finalised attachments and appendices.
