4. Inclusive Growth & City Inequality

GN gave a presentation outlining deprivation and inequality across areas of Cardiff. The presentation also considered in more detail the Ely/Caerau area of Cardiff.

A discussion followed on the role of the PSB in addressing these challenges, focussed particularly on the need for greater integration of public services at the locality level, whilst also acknowledging the importance of considering the influence of economic development, education and employment opportunities at the pan Cardiff level.
